Abstracts that pertain to research projects that encompass this year’s theme will be given priority in the determination of oral presentation. 1. The deadline for pre-registration is February 14, 2011. The registration fee is \$10 for students, technicians and fellow and \$25 for faculty.
2. Registration and abstract submission must be made electronically. This year registration fees will be paid on line only. Registration forms including fee payment are available on TCRB website.
3. We encourage EVERYONE to try and present a poster as these presentations are an essential aspect of the TCRB meeting. Deadline for abstract submission is February 14<sup>th</sup>. Poster titles and authors will be listed on our website by February 18<sup>th</sup>.
4. We encourage attendees to meet the vendors and to that end there will be designated times to meet them in Vendor Fairs
5. In order to foster networking, this year there will be the opportunity for students, fellows and others to sign up for the lunch table of one of the speakers. Please mark your registration forms with your preferences.
